SCARCITY	ABUNDANCE
There is never enough	There is always more where that came from
Stingy with knowledge, contacts and compassion	Happy to share knowledge, contacts and compassion
Default to suspicion; hard to build rapport	Default to rapport and build trust easily
Resent competition. Makes the pie smaller, them weaker	Welcome competitors. Makes the pie larger, them stronger
