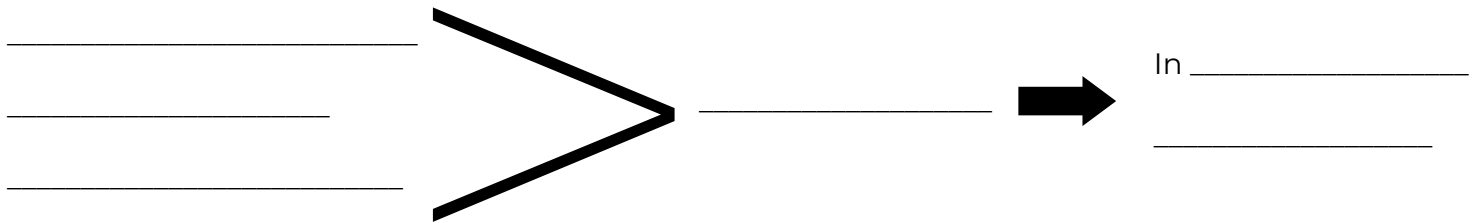

Ephesians Compared to Colossians

Ephesians	Colossians
Jesus Christ: Lord of the <i>church</i>	Jesus Christ: Lord of the <i>cosmos</i>
Emphasis on the church as the body of Christ but also affirms Christ as Head of the church	Emphasis on Christ as the Head of the cosmos and the church
Less personal and probably a circular epistle. Addresses the errors of false teaching less directly (heresy is not yet a major danger).	More personal and local-church-oriented. Speaks to the errors of false doctrine directly (heresy is more threatening).
